COMPARTMENTALIZATION

CERTIFIED SAFE.

WHAT?

Compartmentalization was introduced by the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) in 2002 and was adopted by the National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP) in 2006. The NPIP developed management guidelines in 2014 to provide international trading partners confidence in the health status of imported breeding stock.

WHY?

This certification provides assurance of AI-free product supply. Companies with this certification are recognized for operating at high levels of biosecurity. It also allows for business continuity provisions for animal health crises – the freedom of transport across state/country lines for animal feed, animal feed ingredients, live poultry and egg transport.

HOW?

A stringent, uncompromising biosecurity program, along with skillful flock management and frequent health monitoring. We've established protocols that exceed what is required so importing officials have a high degree of confidence in our products.

WHERE?

UNITED STATES

This certification is managed by the USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service's National Poultry Improvement Plan Program (NPIP).

BRAZIL

This certification is managed by the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply (MAPA) and approved by the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE).

NETHERLANDS

This certification is managed by the Netherlands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority (NVWA).

UNITED KINGDOM

This certification is managed by the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA).

BIOSECURITY

NO COMPROMISE.

WE TAKE BIOSECURITY SERIOUSLY.

Biosecurity is non-negotiable for our business and has helped protect our supply chain from numerous disease outbreaks for decades.

All facilities are fully bio-secure to prevent disease entry and we follow stringent programs utilizing approved NPIP internal and state labs.

There is extensive auditing, monitoring and approval by third party organizations to ensure we are compliant.

Exceptional biosecurity allows us the ability to distribute broiler breeding stock to more than 120 countries worldwide.

Our protocols exceed the USDA's (United States Department of Agriculture) rigorous standards, to ensure importing officials have a high degree of confidence in our products no matter where they come from.

JUST SOME OF THE WAYS WE MINIMIZE RISKS

- Secure and isolated facilities with mandatory check-in offices/stations
- 5 minute mandatory shower-in/shower-out policy (all Cobb production facilities and hatcheries)
- Facility provided uniforms, boots and equipment/accessories (all washed and sterilized daily)
- Boot wash stations (outside and inside of facilities)
- House clean-out after each flock
- Transport vehicles are cleaned and disinfected between deliveries
- Hand sanitation stations spread through-out all corporate facilities, production facilities, hatcheries, etc.
- Required training and onboarding policies for all Cobb employees worldwide
- Consistent and regular internal and external Quality Assurance audits of all Cobb facilities
- Strict policy on outside bird contact (ie – close contact or actual contact w/ backyard chickens, fowl/duck hunting, birds nests, etc). *Contact can mean required "time out" or depending on severity, up to termination of employment.*
