TOP 10 MALE FEEDING PRACTICES

- 1** Start hen feeder 10 minutes before lights turn on, lower male feeder when lights turn on.
- 2** Use presentation feeding.
- 3** Raise male feeder by 8 a.m.
- 4** Run feed back for next days' feeding after 3 p.m. Best to keep the line uncharged to ensure proper amount was fed.
- 5** Feed 8 to 10 males per pan depending on your feed particle size.
- 6** Use accurate scales.
- 7** Repair swinging or tilted pans.
- 8** Install plastic chain every 50 feet on male feeder auger to help ensure correct height (high enough to prevent hens from eating but low enough so all males can eat).
- 9** Ensure male feeders have same motor size (rpms) on both ends.
- 10** Be sure male feed reaches end pan or within 2-3 pans of it.
